Established in 1977 as a small tutorial college, today Bosworth is a leading independent boarding college in the UK.

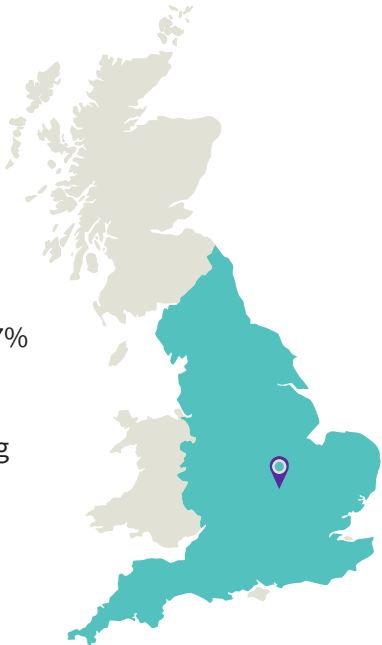
