

LONG-TERM VS SHORT-TERM

LONG-TERM: Students will stay for the duration of the academic year (September - July). Each student must be provided with their own bedroom.

SHORT-TERM: Placements during halfterm holidays when boarding schools close (1-3 weeks). It is acceptable for short-term students to share bedrooms providing there are suitable household provisions.

WHAT OUR HOSTS NEED TO PROVIDE

APPLICANTS

- ✓ Must be aged 25+
- Be suitable to work with children, i.e. not disqualified from working with children
- Be willing for Gateway Education to complete assessment visits
- Take part in online Safeguarding training as a minimum

ACCOMMODATION

Your accommodation must meet the following criteria:

- Good decorative order
- Adequate heating and ventilation
- Working smoke alarms throughout
- A Gas Safety Certificate for each appliance (updated annually)

The room you provide for students must meet the following criteria:

- Good decorative order
- Adequate heating, natural lighting and ventilation
- ✓ A single or double bed
- Good quality duvet and pillows
- 🗸 Wardrobe
- 🗸 Rubbish Bin
- 🗸 Desk
- 🗸 Chair
- 🗸 Desk Lamp

SERVICES

- Meals 2 or 3 meals per day depending on placement type
- Laundry at least once per week
- Adequate towels and bed linen of a good standard must be provided
- Internet access

APPLICATION PROCESS

STEP 1

APPLY Complete application form and send back to Gateway Education accommodation@gateway-education.com

STEP 2

VISIT Our Accommodation Officers will contact you to arrange an assessment visit. They will need to see all areas of the household and meet with all household members. Guidance will be given about hosting international students and what is expected. Visit procedure will be sent prior to appointment.

STEP 3

DOCUMENTATION & CHECKS References for the primary carers of the household will be requested. An enhanced Disclosure and Barring check will be completed for each member of the household over 16 years of age. (Gateway Education will cover the cost of the DBS checks).

STEP 4

TRAINING Primary carer of the household will be required to complete an online Introductory Safeguarding Course.

STEP 5

START HOSTING Gateway Education will confirm once you have been approved to host.
